- Class 2A** Show Jumping only – 50cm, no back rails – single phase
- Class 2B** Combined Training – Pony Club Walk and Trot Dressage Test (2013) and 50cm SJ course

- Class 4B** Combined Training - Pony Club Introduction to Dressage Test (2019) and 70cm SJ course

- Class 5A** Show Jumping only – 80cm - single phase
- Class 5B** Combined Training - Pony Club Grassroots Dressage Test (2018) and 80cm SJ course
- Class 6** Dressage only - Pony Club 90 Eventing Test (2013)
- Class 6A** Show Jumping only – 90cm - single phase
- Class 6B** Combined Training - Pony Club Novice Eventing Test (2013) and 90cm SJ course
Height of fences for Jumping – 90cm
- Class 7** Dressage only - Pony Club Novice Dressage Test (2020)
- Class 8** Dressage only – Pony Club Intermediate Dressage Test (2013)
- Entry Fees Dressage Test only - £10.00 (Classes 1,2,3,4,5, 6, 7 and 8)
Show Jumping class only - £10.00 (Classes 1A, 2A, 3A, 4A, 5A and 6A)
Combined Training - £18.00 (Dressage and SJ - Classes 1B, 2B, 3B, 4B, 5B and 6B)

Rules

- All Vehicles parked at own risk. Entries accepted at rider’s own risk.
- The organiser reserves the right to refuse an entry, alter the order of classes or cancel classes. Entries will be strictly limited and organisers reserve the right not to take entries once the class has started. All horses and ponies must be four years old and over.
- Hard hats must be worn when mounted, be PC tagged (aquamarine tag) and chinstraps should be fastened. The hat standards accepted as of 1st January 2019 are - PAS 015:1998 or 2011* with BSI Kitemark, VG1 with BSI Kitemark, Snell E2001* onwards with the official Snell label and number, ASTM-F1163 2004a onwards with the SEI mark and AS/NZS 3838 2006 onwards.
- Correct dress and footwear must be worn when riding. Body protectors strongly recommended for competitors when show jumping.
- The Competition will run under Pony Club Dressage and Show Jumping Rules 2020
- **All Dressage tests will be allowed to be called with no penalty.**
- Any objections must be handed to the secretary in writing with a deposit of £10 within half an hour of the incident. In the event that the objection is not upheld, the deposit will be forfeited.
