The competition will consist of a Show Jumping round followed immediately by the timed Cross-Country section comprised of a mixture of portable cross country fences and JAS Style fences with an undisclosed optimum time. The winning combination will be the horse/pony with the least penalties and the closest to the optimum time.

Class 1 – 50/60cm

Show jumping: Max Height : 60cm

Cross Country: Max Height: 60cm

Class 2 – 70cm

Show jumping: Max Height : 70cm

Cross Country: Max Height: 70cm

Class 3 – 80cm

Show jumping: Max Height : 80cm

Cross Country: Max Height: 80cm

Class 4 – 90cm

Show jumping: Max Height : 90cm

Cross Country: Max Height: 90cm



Riders only 8 years old and over will be permitted to enter this competition.

DRESS CODE - Cross country attire for both phases.

General Rules

HATS must be worn whenever mounted and conform to PAS015 (1998 or 2011). VG01.040 2014-12. with a BSI Kite mark or Inspec IC mark

ASTM F1163.2004a onwards with SEI mark SNELL E2001 or 2016 (No additional mark required)

ONLY Jockey skull hats without a peak (greater than 5mm smooth and rounded in nature) may be worn for cross country. Hat silks may be worn with flexible peak. It must also comply with the above safety standards for hats.

BODY PROTECTORS A body protector is obligatory for all arena eventing and cross-country events and are also strongly recommended for all show jumping events. A BETA Level 3 (purple label) which has a 2009 label OR Blue 2018 label must be worn. Body protectors should be fitted and worn as per the manufacturer's instructions. If a rider chooses to wear an airbag style body protector it must be worn over a permitted body protector and if activated, must be deflated or removed before continuing. Hybrid Air jackets and Helite Air Jackets are permitted. It is recommended that body protectors are replaced once they are more than 5 years old. Riders wearing Exo Body Cage protectors must inform the secretary at all events.

Stop watches are NOT permitted.

CORRECT dress & footwear must be worn. Long hair is to be suitably tied up.

ALL horses and ponies must be four years old and over. Riders only 8 years old and over will be permitted to enter this competition.

ENTRIES accepted at rider's risk. SRC reserve the right to refuse an entry at their discretion, cancel, amend or amalgamate any class for any reason whatsoever. The Judge's decision is final.

INSURANCE Each competitor must carry their own liability insurance whether Riding Club, Pony Club, BHS, BS, BD, BE or independent cover.

HEALTH & SAFETY The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.

Those attending this event must report any accidents to the secretary or organizer of the event

Please do not leave unattended horses tied to lorries and no hay nets to be tied to the outside of lorries or trailers.

Solihull Riding Club welcomes responsible dog owners. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.

Please do not enter the arena more than 45 minutes before your allotted time in order to warm up.

Please ensure you bring an adequate supply of water for you and your horse.

Government guidelines could change quickly at any time; therefore Solihull Riding Club reserve the right to close site at short notice.
