Riders to stipulate on their ODE entries to SRC their Services section and which service they represent – with collar details for verification purposes.

Teams can be made up of 3 or 4 riders in the following formats:

- All team members in 50-60cm (class 1)
- A mix of all other classes across Saturday (for example all riders competing at the same height, or one in the 70, one in the 80, two in the 90 etc.)

**If you don't have a team ready but would like to be entered as a team, please let us know when entering and we will group you together with other riders.**

Please be sure to specify which class each team member will be competing in.

**PRIZES – Medals for individuals and teams.**

There will be a prize giving at the end of each class on our podium for individuals to receive rosettes and medals.

There will be an unmounted prize giving for teams at the end of the competition (time will be specified when times are released). If you are unable to attend the prize giving, please leave us a stamped SAE.

Rosettes to 10<sup>th</sup> Place in each section. **If you would like your rosette but are unable to pick it up on the day, please leave a stamped SAE.**

Prizes Class 1 - will be awarded for every 10 starters up to 4<sup>th</sup> place.

- 1<sup>st</sup> £35.00 BACS (10 starters),
- 2<sup>nd</sup> £25.00 BACS (11 – 20),
- 3<sup>rd</sup> £20.00 voucher (21-30)

If the event is cancelled due to COVID Restrictions between **6<sup>th</sup> -10<sup>th</sup> September 2021**, your start fee and 50% of your entry fee will be refunded.

## **RULES**

### **BODY PROTECTORS MUST BE WORN FOR CROSS-COUNTRY PHASE FOR ALL CLASSES**

1. BHS Riding Club "Rules for Official Competitions" 2021 with Area 5 amendments.
2. Objections to be made in writing to the Organisers, accompanied by a deposit of £20, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
3. The course will be open for inspection from **2.00pm on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> September 2021.**

#### **General Rules**

HATS must be worn whenever mounted and conform to PAS015 (1998 or 2011). VG01.040 2014-12. with a BSI Kite mark or Inspec IC mark

ASTM F1163.2004a onwards with SEI mark SNELL E2001 or 2016 (No additional mark required)

ONLY Jockey skull hats without a peak (greater than 5mm smooth and rounded in nature) may be worn for cross country. Hat silks may be worn with flexible peak. It must also comply with the above safety standards for hats.

BODY PROTECTORS A body protector is obligatory for all arena eventing and cross-country events and are also strongly recommended for all show jumping events. A BETA Level 3 2009 (purple label) or 2018 (blue label) must be worn. Body protectors should be fitted and worn as per the manufacturer's instructions. If a rider chooses to wear an airbag style body protector it must be worn over a permitted body protector and if activated, must be deflated or removed before continuing. Hybrid Air jackets and Helite Air Jackets are permitted. It is recommended that body protectors are replaced once they are more than 5 years old. Riders wearing Exo Body Cage protectors must inform the secretary at all events.

CORRECT dress & footwear with defined heels must be worn. Long hair is to be suitably tied up.

ALL horses and ponies must be five years old and over. **ALL Riders to be 8 years old and over.**

ENTRIES accepted at rider's risk. SRC reserve the right to refuse an entry at their discretion, cancel, amend or amalgamate any class for any reason whatsoever. The Judge's decision is final.

INSURANCE Each competitor must carry their own liability insurance whether Riding Club, Pony Club, BHS, BS, BD, BE or independent cover.

HEALTH & SAFETY The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards. Those attending this event must report any accidents to the secretary or organizer of the event

Please do not leave unattended horses tied to lorries and no hay nets to be tied to the outside of lorries or trailers.

Solihull Riding Club welcomes responsible dog owners. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
