- CLASS 1: **CROSS POLES** Section A = lead rein/ assisted Section B = unassisted
- □ CLASS 2: **HEIGHT OF FENCES: 30cm** Section A = lead rein/ assisted Section B = unassisted
- CLASS 3: HEIGHT OF FENCES: 40cm Section A = lead rein/ assisted Section B = unassisted
- CLASS 4: HEIGHT OF FENCES: 50cm Section A = lead rein/ assisted Section B = unassisted
- □ CLASS 5: HEIGHT OF FENCES: 60cm Section A = lead rein/ assisted Section B = unassisted

Classes will only be split into sections if there are more than 10 entries per class.

The series will run on a points system for each class to 10<sup>th</sup> place. Please see below for a break down of the points system. You will need to acquire 4 points or more to be eligible for the championship show.



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- 1<sup>st</sup> = 10 points
- $2^{nd} = 9$  points
- $3^{rd} = 8$  points
- $4^{th} = 7$  points
- $5^{th} = 6$  points
- 6<sup>th</sup> = 5 points
- 7<sup>th</sup> = 4 points
- 8<sup>th</sup> = 3 points
- 9<sup>th</sup> = 2 points
- $10^{th} = 1 point$

#### To qualify for the championship class, you need to of obtained 4 points or more!

The rider with the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> highest league points will win an overall prize at the end of the season.

- Entries close the preceding 48 hours at 9am. Late entries will be taken at a £3 charge per class. If classes are full a waiting list will be kept.
- Telephone entries will <u>no longer be taken</u> all entries should be made online at <u>www.solihullridingclub.co.uk/events</u>
- Withdrawals: In the unfortunate event of withdrawal, please advise the secretary by 9am on the Thursday prior to the competition.
- □ We regret no refunds will be made once times are issued.
- □ No transfers will be made after 9am on the preceding day.
- Times: Will be available online after 4.00pm 48 hours prior to the event. at <u>www.solihullridingclub.co.uk/times</u>
- □ Any special requests must be clearly put onto entry.
- Bridle numbers OR saddle pad numbers must be worn. ONE ON EACH SIDE
- □ Horses may only enter once in each class competitively.
- Any objections or complaints MUST be done so through a legitimate complaint's procedure. You must place a £10.00 deposit alongside your written complaint. This complaint will then be assessed by the executive committee. If your complaint is found to be legitimate, you will be refunded your £10.00.

#### WE WILL ONLY SPLIT SECTIONS IF THERE ARE 10 OR MORE STARTERS PER CLASS

#### **General Rules**

HATS must be worn whenever mounted and should be to the correct current standard.

ONLY Jockey skull hats without a peak (greater than 5mm smooth and rounded in nature) may be worn for cross country. Hat silks may be worn with flexible peak. It must also comply with safety standards for hats.

BODY PROTECTORS A body protector is obligatory for all arena eventing and cross-country events and are also strongly recommended for all show jumping events. Body protectors should be fitted and worn as per the manufacturer's instructions. If a rider chooses to wear an airbag style body protector it must be worn over a permitted body protector and if activated, must be deflated or removed before continuing. Hybrid Air jackets and

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Helite Air Jackets are permitted. It is recommended that body protectors are replaced once they are more than 5 years old. Riders wearing Exo Body Cage protectors must inform the secretary at all events.

CORRECT dress & footwear with defined heels must be worn. ALL horses and ponies must be four years old and over. **ALL Riders to be 4** years old and over.

ENTRIES accepted at rider's risk. SRC reserve the right to refuse an entry at their discretion, cancel, amend or amalgamate any class for any reason whatsoever. The Judge's decision is final.

INSURANCE Each competitor must carry their own liability insurance whether Riding Club, Pony Club, BHS, BS, BD, BE or independent cover.

HEALTH & SAFETY The organisers of this event have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards. Those attending this event must report any accidents to the secretary or organizer of the event

Please do not leave unattended horses tied to lorries and no hay nets to be tied to the outside of lorries or trailers. Solihull Riding Club welcomes responsible dog owners. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
